
Let me tell you all how proud I am to be able to share with you in living our dreams to improve the lives of our impoverished women and girls throughout the world.

WHEREAS, the term of office of the Governor and other elected officers of the Region are nor specifically stated/provided in the By-Laws of the Foundation;

WHEREAS, there is a need to make a specific proviso in the By-Laws of the Foundation as to when the term of office of the Governor and other elected officers of the Region shall commence and end in order to have a clear statement and/or determination of the period for which they are to serve in the respective offices for which they were elected;

WHEREAS, the said provision as to the term of office of the Governor and other officers of the Region shall be stated under Article VII and inserted as Section 2 of the By-Laws of the Foundation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as it is HEREBY RESOLVED by the undersigned Members of the Board of Trustees that the By-Laws of Soroptimist International of the Philippines Region (A Foundation), Inc., be amended to state thus:

ARTICLE VIII, Section 2: TERM OF OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR AND OTHER ELECTED OFFICERS OF THE REGION

The term of office of the Governor and other elected officers of the Region shall commence on the 1st day of July immediately following a Biennial Conference and end on 30th June two (2) years thereafter or after the end of the biennium.

“A RESOLUTION FIXING THE PERIOD FOR PAYMENT OF SIPRF DUES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR LATE PAYMENTS THEREOF”

WHEREAS, the last day of payment for SIA dues is July 1st of each year with a thirty (30) days grace period or until July 31st;

WHEREAS, in order to have a uniform period of payments for both SIA and SIPRF dues by clubs, it is hereby resolved that payment of club dues to SIPRF shall be on or before July 1, with a thirty (30) day grace period or until July 31st;

WHEREAS, in order to ensure diligent payment of SIPRF dues by clubs, it is likewise resolved that:

- If by August 1 a club fails to pay its SIPRF dues, it shall be assessed a penalty of P100.00 per member;
- If no payment is made by September 1, a club shall be assessed a penalty of P200.00 per member;
- If October 1 its club dues still remain unpaid, the non-paying club shall be recommended for disbandment to Soroptimist International of the Americas (SIA);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as it is HEREBY RESOLVED by the undersigned members of the BOARD OF TRUSTEES that:

1. The deadline for payment of SIPRF dues by clubs shall be July 1 with a thirty (30) days grace period or until July 31;
2. If by August a club fails to pay its SIPRF dues, it shall be assessed a penalty of P100.00 per member;
3. If no payment is made by September 1, a club shall be assessed a penalty of P200.00 per member;
4. If by October 1 a club's dues still remain unpaid, the non-paying club shall be recommended for disbandment to Soroptimist International of the Americas (SIA)
